Abstract

Suppose G is the matrix group SL_2 , considered as a variety over your favorite algebraically closed field of characteristic zero. Can we write down a variety X with an algebraic transitive action of G , so that the space of regular functions on X contains every irreducible finite-dimensional representation of G *once and exactly once*? We will present a solution to this question which suggests how the same question should be answered for more ambitious choices of G .
